own**

Most High he will not be
shaken.**

**B. El-Elyon provides for
His own**

Deuteronomy 32:8--13

**"When the Most High gave
the nations their inheritance,
when He separated the sons
of man, He set the
boundaries of the peoples...
He found him in a desert
land, and in the howling
waste of a wilderness;**

**He encircled him, He cared
for him, He guarded him as
the pupil of His eye. Like an
eagle that stirs up its nest,
that hovers over its young,
He spread His wings and
caught them, He carried
them on His pinions.**

**The LORD alone guided him,
and there was no foreign
god with him. He made him
ride on the high places of the
earth, and he ate the
produce of the field;**

**and He made him suck
honey from the rock, and oil
from the flinty rock, (NAU)**

**They remembered that
God was their rock,
and the Most High God
their Redeemer.**

**C. El-Elyon restores His
own**

3. El-Elyon Purifies

**A. Knowing El-Elyon
hinders sin**

**For the LORD Most High
is to be feared, a great
King over all the earth.
Psalm 47:2(NAU)**

The LORD judges the peoples; vindicate me, O LORD, according to my righteousness and my integrity that is in me. O let the evil of the wicked come to an end, but establish the righteous;

**for the righteous God tries
the hearts and minds. 17 I
will give thanks to the LORD
according to His
righteousness and will sing
praise to the name of the
LORD Most High. (NAU)**

**Yet they tempted and
rebelled against the Most
High God and did not
keep His testimonies,
Psalm 78:56 (NAU)**

**"VENGEANCE IS MINE, I
WILL REPAY." And again,
"THE LORD WILL JUDGE HIS
PEOPLE." It is a terrifying
thing to fall into the hands of
the living God. Hebrews
10:30-31 (NAU)**

**B. Knowing El-Elyon
crushes pride**

Psalm 107:10--13

**There were those who dwelt
in darkness and in the
shadow of death, prisoners
in misery and chains,
because they had rebelled
against the words of God
and spurned the counsel of
the Most High.**

Therefore He humbled their heart with labor; they stumbled and there was none to help. Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble; He saved them out of their distresses. (NAU)

present my firstborn for
my rebellious acts, the
fruit of my body for the
sin of my soul?**

**He has told you, O man,
what is good; and what
does the LORD require of
you but to do justice, to
love kindness, and to
walk humbly with your
God? (NAU)**

**D. Angels praised El-
Elyon**

Luke 1:32—35

"He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David; and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever,

**and His kingdom will have
no end." Mary said to the
angel, "How can this be,
since I am a virgin?" The
